Feb 24/25

GIVE DRINK TO THE THIRSTY **March 3/4**

Donations of canned coffee and bottle juice will benefit IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SHELTER for men. Donation boxes are in the back of the Church.

SHELTER THE HOMELESS
